ONLY if there are more than 20 authors; in that case, be sure to include all relevant first and corresponding/senior authors.
e.g. Thiru A, Nietlispach D, Mott HR, Okuwaki M, Lyon D, Nielsen PR, ... Laue ED. Structural basis of HP1/PXVXL motif peptide interactions and HP1 localisation to heterochromatin. EMBO J. (2004) 23: 489-499

350 words max, excluding references.
